- **Sean Brady announced a Mill/Inlay Project along I-25 including SB Offramp to**

Cerrillos Road.

- **Jacqueline Beam announced the RFP Draft for Electric Charging Stations (33 ports) has been released and working on an EV Transition Plan for the County.**
- **Andrew Baca announced the New Dispatch software is working well with a less than 1% margin of error. 2 of the 3 shuttles needed for Micro-Transit have been purchased. Slight delay on the 3rd. Looking forward to the Zozobra event where they moved 9000 passengers last year.**
- **Brett Clavio brought up a regional map from the draft 2025 MTP and needed some clarification on a proposed trail alignment. He also spoke of the need to discuss future transit option in Sustainable Development Area 1 (Community College District).**
- **Bryce Gibson announced NCRTD will be hiring new director soon, and have bids out to provide the first Micro-Transit services to the La Cienega Community soon. They have also hired a new Transit Analysis Specialist.**
